

THE HOLYOKE REVOLVER CLUB VOLUNTEER REWARDS PROGRAM

The Holyoke Revolver Club's (HRC) Board of Offices (BoO) has unanimously approved a volunteers rewards program presented by the Members Committee.

The Board of Officers would like to thank committee chair Paul Sullivan, Ed Meyer, Gretta Tucker, Peter Bernard, Madeline Davidson, Bruce Whittier, and Maureen Couture for their time and hard work in fostering this great program.

Through this program, each HRC volunteer would receive Volunteer Bucks (V-Buck) for each event they volunteer for, and each event leader would receive 5 V-Bucks for conducting an HRC event.

The redemption of V-Bucks earned will include credit toward club events, and merchandise (t-shirts, hats, hoodies and more).

As of November 1, 2021, we have started tallying V-Bucks for the reward program.

V-Bucks are rewarded as follows:

- a. Training Coordinator - 5 V-Bucks for setting up the training class.
- b. Class Instructors - 40 V-Bucks for the day.
- c. Class Administrator BPSC - 20 V-Bucks for the day.
- d. RSO/Coach at the BPSC, 101, and First Shots - 5 V-bucks for the afternoon
- e. General Category - Amount to be determined by the BoO on a case-by-case basis. (Spring clean-up, special projects, etc.)
- f. The Fun Shoot, Practical Shoot, and Governor's 6-Gun are considered "total participant events" and will not receive V-bucks.
The Event Leader may give 1 V-Buck to someone who does not participate and or goes above and beyond.
- g. Event Leader - 5 V-Bucks for each HRC event held:
(Practical shoot, Governor 6. and Fun Shoot)
- h. Maintenance team - 5 V-Bucks for the day.

The Duties and Rules for the V-Bucks Program

EVENT LEADER: 1. Responsible for submitting volunteer information to the Banker at membercommittee@holyokerevolverclub.com ,
2. Answer any volunteer's questions about hours.

BANKER (Secretary): Maintain database of volunteer V-Bucks. (Soon to be on the HRC website - members will be able to check their V-Bucks to see what they have earned and used.)

VOLUNTEER: Sign in and out on sign in sheet. Receive an invoice to submit to Banker.

RULES:

- The rewards program is open to all members in good standing.
- All V-Bucks will remain valid for as long as the volunteer remains a HRC member I.A.W. Club By-Laws.
- V-Bucks cannot be used for impulse purchase. (Drinks, snacks and targets).
- V-bucks can be transferred to other HRC members, to be used for classes and events.
- V-bucks can be used to pay for a safety class for non-member.
- V-bucks have no monetary value and have to be used in their entirety.
- V-Bucks will be limited to 495 V-Bucks per person each year
- BoO duties are not eligible for this program .
